The description of the academic position	Associate professor, position 7, Department of Letters, Educational Sciences and International Relations. The disciplines in the structure of the position can be found in the curriculum of the undergraduate programs LLE_LLRL and RISE within the Faculty of Educational Sciences, Law, and Public Administration. Additionally, the position includes, besides teaching activities, guidance for bachelor's theses, evaluation activities, and consultations. The position is open for an indefinite period. The opportunity to open this position for competition arises from the perspective of evaluating for the purpose of reaccreditation of the undergraduate programs RISE and LLE_LLRL, as it is necessary to ensure compliance with the ARACIS Standards regarding the coverage of positions established in the Staffing Chart of the Department of Letters, Educational Sciences, and International Relations, with tenured teaching staff. Associate professor post (position 7) is proposed for open competition for an indefinite period, taking into account the need to develop a sustainable human resources policy, aimed at ensuring the teaching of specialized subjects by teaching staff trained in the specialty of the subjects, and , at the same time, towards the consolidation of research activities, an essential element for the periodic evaluation of bachelor's and master's degree programs and for the higher education institution.

Description of the competition procedure	The competition is carried out in accordance with the Framework Methodology for the competition for vacant teaching and research positions in higher education, approved by Government Decision no. 1339/2023, Law no. 199/2023 - the Higher Education Law, and the Methodology for filling teaching and research positions at the "Constantin Brâncuși" University of Târgu Jiu, approved during the Senate meeting on 13.03.2024.

The application for registration, signed by the candidate, which includes a statement on his own responsibility regarding the veracity of the information presented in the file; A2. Proposal for the development of the candidate's career both from the didactic point of view and from the point of view of the scientific research activities; the proposal is drafted by the candidate, comprises a maximum of 10 pages; A3. Curriculum vitae of the candidate - Europass model - in original form signed by the candidate on each page. The candidate's Curriculum Vitae in electronic format, as a PDF, without signature, which in the 'Personal Information' section shall include only the candidate's first name, last name, and optionally, email address. The candidate assumes that both the printed and electronic formats contain the same information, except for personal data (address, phone, email, etc.) and signature, omitted in the electronic document. Curriculum Vitae must include: information about the studies carried out and the diplomas obtained; relevant professional experience and jobs; information on the research and development projects he/she has led as a project director or as a member, indicating for each source of funding, the volume of funding and the main publications or patents resulting; information on awards or other elements recognizing the candidate's scientific contributions, other relevant information; A4. List of papers of the candidate in printed format (original, signed on each page) and in electronic format, as a PDF, without signature. The candidate assumes that both the printed and electronic formats contain the same information, except for the signature, omitted in the electronic document. List of papers will be structured as follows: the list of the maximum 10 papers considered by the candidate to be the most relevant for his own professional achievements, which are included in the file and electronic format in the file and which can be found in the other categories of papers provided for in this article; doctoral thesis or theses; books and book chapters; articles / studies, published in journals from the main international scientific stream; publications in extenso, published in papers of the main specialized international conferences; research/development-innovation projects on the basis of a contract/grant which he has led as a project director or in which he/she has acted as a member, indicating for each source of funding; patents and other industrial property titles; other works and scientific contributions or, as the case may be, in the field of artistic creation; A5. A19. Statement of responsibility, in original (handwritten) signed by the candidate. A20. The folder comprising a maximum of ten of the candidate's most significant papers, in electronic scanned form (CD / DVD), and the books and book chapters will be submitted in physical format. In addition, the electronic support will include the list of papers of the
